



Dress Code

All members of the Monsignor Lee Catholic School community shall adopt a standard of dress that is appropriate for a Catholic school. The way we dress must reflect our commitment to a safe, positive and respectful environment. Students are to dress respectfully at school, and at school sponsored events. Each student is an ambassador for Monsignor Lee at all times.



Pants are to cover all underwear.



Only hemmed shorts and walking shorts that reach mid thigh are permitted.



Please remember to use the 2 finger wide rule for all grades. Spaghetti straps are not permitted and no undergarments are to be visible.



Hats and caps are to be removed when inside the school.

All clothing will be free of derogatory or inappropriate print or graphics.

Please no skull or cross bone graphics for all grades.



All tops will cover the full midriff and will cover the top of pants.



Pants are to be free from rips, no skin to be showing.

The consequences for students who are inappropriately dressed will be as follows:

- Students will be reminded of the school dress code initially and asked to modify their appearance (i.e. turn shirt inside out/put sweater on) or
- Parents contacted to bring alternate clothing or
- Students may be required to work in the office for the day
